LHM History

Habakkuk 2:2 says "Then the Lord answered me and said "write the vision and make it plain on tablets that he may run who reads it. For the vision is yet for and appointed time; But at the end it will speak and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it because it will surely come. It will not tarry."

Lighthouse Ministries (LHM) was manifested and birthed through a vision from the Holy Spirit given to Pastor Joseph Dean IV in 1998. The vision that he carried in his belly was to Lead God's People Through the Storm, which is what our mission has become. Pastor Dean's vision was to be a pastor of pastors.

LHM is a ministry developed for people who are lost and burned out from traditions, searching to find the ultimate light. LHM's mission is not to teach the Bible to the learner, but to teach the learner the Bible so that they receive the word with all readiness of mind and search the scripture daily.

Bible study was the start of this new vision. It began in the living room on West Cypress Ct. with only six (6) people and was held on Monday nights for two years. In 2007, the now growing ministry incorporated the Word of the Day and moved Bible study to Tuesdays. During that year the ministry had its first Family and Friends Day at Sheridan Heights Community Center, as well as, a Restoration and Dedication Service.

As 2008 rolled in, LHM initially began its church services every month on the first (1st) Sunday. Also, the second annual Friends and Family Day included a trip to Six Flags in Atlanta, Georgia. The partners of LHM began a mentoring program with the Montgomery Job Corps Center and participated with helping the Salvation Army during Thanksgiving by distributing and serving food to the community to spread the news about this ministry.

In 2009 the ministry really began to spread its wings. The ministry went from having service on the first (1st) Sunday to having service on the third (3rd) Sunday as well. The patio of Pastor & First Lady Dean's home underwent construction and would serve as the new location for the sanctuary. As the progress was completed on the sanctuary, LHM was blessed with a praise leader and was able to establish several auxiliaries within the ministry. Later in the year we had our first Pastor Appreciation Program.

Also in 2009, the ministry went to Alabama Adventure for its Annual Friends and Family Trip with a caravan of 10 vehicles. LHM also did its part and spread the ministry across the water by sending the troops a care package while they protected and served for the country. The first (1st) baptismal service for Lighthouse Ministries was held at Mount Ramah Primitive Baptist Church where we had several young people to accept Christ as their personal Savior. During the holiday season, the first (1st) Christmas dinner and first (1st) watch night service was held to remember Christ's birth.

The year 2010 was a year that God took LHM even higher. The partners of the ministry went on a corporate fast and as a result of fasting and praying, the ministry was able to: purchase two (2) vans in cash, acquired sound equipment by donation, development of the children's ministry and development and sharpening gifts of the spirit by having a supernatural experience like the Day of Pentecost. From that point forward, LHM

knew that God could and would provide. The ministry incorporated a Teen Pampering Day for the young adults and continued its Annual Trip to the Georgia Aquarium and the Cocoa Cola Factory in Atlanta, Georgia. Because of the rapid moving and shaking going on in the ministry, the Bible study was yet again moved to another day, Wednesdays, to accommodate growing partnerships and the ministry schedule.

The year of 2011 was a year of movement indeed. The ministry said goodbye to the Patio and moved into True Word of Life Worship Center, located at the old Wynnsong Movie Theater. On February 27, 2011 the ministry had its first (1st) service in the newly acquired sanctuary. During this move, a local home daycare, Tomorrow's Promise, became a partner with LHM and would soon operate under the ministry's umbrella. In April of the same year, the Lord blessed the ministry with a musician. The movie theater served as the LHM home for a total of seven (7) months and it was time for the sanctuary to be redecorated once more. Prior to moving into its new home in October, the ministry threw a Surprise Celebration for the sister churches (Mt. Ramah, St. Paul, and New Vision) and their pastors and ministers in Greenville, AL.

The new home of LHM, now located at 128 Mendel Parkway, was a place the ministry could call its own. The audio system was put in place and the bathrooms repainted. It had ample space for the Daycare and the Sanctuary, as well as a Pastor Study and Office. It also came with a nice kitchen that would deem useful for all the meals that LHM likes to serve. The ministry purchased its very first (1st) set of black banquet style chairs for seating and later obtained 177 padded sanctuary chairs from Lakewood Christian Centre as a donation. After seeing that it was able to accommodate a large amount of people, the ministry held its first (1st) Christmas Musical Toy and Food Drive with an attendance well over 200 with no seats to spare.

Lighthouse Ministries Family Youth Center continues to be a vital part of the community as it grows spiritual and in numbers. Everything that was implemented in prior years is still ongoing and continues to be a work in progress.
